

## Year 7 Catch Up Statement 2017-2018

The Year 7 Catch Up premium is a Government initiative whereby additional funding is allocated to schools to help to support pupils who did not meet the expected standard in Maths and/or English at Key Stage 2. The money was previously allocated based on the number of pupils who did not receive a Level 4 or higher in Maths and English in the KS2 SATs, but for the last two years this has changed to pupils who are not deemed 'secondary ready'.

We received £9665 funding in 2017 for Year 7 catch up. This was spent on purchasing part of the Accelerated Reader scheme to support English at a cost of £1500 and the rest of the money was spent on intervention, both through additional timetabled lessons and through small group work or one to one support. All pupils in the catch up cohort for Maths, English or both are monitored carefully to ensure that any additional support is having the intended impact.
