

## Year 7 Catch Up Statement 2018-2019

The Year 7 Catch Up premium is a Government initiative whereby additional funding is allocated to schools to help to support pupils who did not meet the expected standard in Maths and/or English at Key Stage 2. The money was previously allocated based on the number of pupils who did not receive a Level 4 or higher in Maths and English in the KS2 SATs, but for the last two years this has changed to pupils who are not deemed 'secondary ready'.

We have received £9665 funding for this academic year. We plan to spend £1500 to purchase a proportion of the Accelerated Reader Scheme to support reading in English. £500 will be spent on resources and £7655 on additional teaching periods used for intervention and small group teaching. All pupils in the catch up cohort for Maths, English or both are monitored carefully to ensure that any additional support is having the intended impact.
